ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur female golfers who 1) have an up-to-date 18-hole USGA Handicap Index not to exceed 10.4 under the USGA Handicap System, 2) are members of a golf club, organization or association that is a 2010 WWGA member. Club Membership Information and Application Form are available on the website.

ENTRY INFORMATION

\$175.00 entry fee must accompany the entry application form. \$175.00 + \$35.00 for foreign entries must accompany the entry application form payable by check in US currency. (\$35.00 is in lieu of WWGA club membership dues). Entry deadline: June 15, 2010 at 5:00 P.M. (EDT). Entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time by the WWGA Amateur Tournament Committee. Entries will be notified of acceptance or wait list. Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted. \$25.00 administrative fee will be withheld for cancellations of accepted entries on or before June 15. No refunds for cancellations after June 15. Field limited to the low 144 players.
