In fairness to the field of competition: In both the stroke play and match play portion of the tournament, it is expected and is the responsibility of every player to continue play throughout the tournament until eliminated. The field plays the Monday (practice round), Tuesday and Wednesday rounds. Wednesday, the field will be cut to 32 players for the championship.

REGULATIONS, FOOTWEAR & PERSONAL APPEARANCE

For Players, Caddies and Spectators

Distance-measuring device. LOCAL RULE: In this competition a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. elevation, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

No metal or ceramic spikes permitted. No short shorts or short skirts, jeans, cut-offs, tank tops, halters, bathing suits, or the like. Appropriate golf attire must be worn at all times when using the practice facility, putting green, the golf course and the entire clubhouse facility.

Spectators: No dogs allowed on the course. Spectators shall walk at all times. On the course, spectator cell phones must be on the 'silent only' setting.

Spectator Cart Policy: A spectator seeking a cart due to a disability as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act must submit a medical certificate. Requests due to temporary injuries or impairments that do not qualify under the ADA will not be granted. All requests must go through the Tournament Chairman. Spectator carts may or may not be available at the tournament site. The WWGA will try to accommodate spectators whenever possible.

Note: Recreational vehicles, campers, motorhomes or the like will not be permitted to park on the Mistwood Golf Club premises. Tailgating will not be permitted.
