**15 Year Old Mika Liu is Medalist at
Women's Western Golf Association's
114th National Amateur Championship**

Mika Liu is a 15 year old who shares time between her home in Beverly Hills, California and Bradenton, Florida where she has just completed Grade 9 at the IMG Academy. IMG is a renowned Sports Academy where youth from all over the world perfect their skills in various sports, including the game of golf.

Liu was an AJGA Rolex All American in 2012 and 2013 and has participated in the last 3 US Girls Junior Championships. She recently won the Women's Southern Amateur Championship. Liu shot a 71 today to match yesterday's 73 for a 2 day total of 144.

Also sharing the low round of 71 was Allison Cooper, a resident of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. A Senior to be at Central Dauphin High School, her lowest round ever was 64 which stands as the high school record. With her first day score of 74, her two day total was 145.

Turning in a score of 72 was Princess Superal, Dasmaringas City, Cavite, The

Philippines which gave her a 2 day total of 146. The 17 year old has won both Junior and Amateur tournaments in Singapore, Malaysia and The Philippines, and qualified for the US Girls Junior Championship in 2012.

A high point of the day was a Hole-In-One recorded by Angela Codian on the 12th hole. The Massillon, Ohio resident who attends Ohio University recorded her first Ace using her 7 Iron which flew right into the cup on the 147 yard hole.

As day turned into evening, the last four spots were open and 8 players tied at 158 were headed back onto the golf course. As darkness appeared, the 4 players headed into
