

One Over Par Leads the 92nd WWGA Junior Championship, Cincinnati Country Club, Cincinnati, Ohio

CINCINNATI, OH. (July 16, 2018)- It is tight at the top of the leader board after Monday's first round of the 92nd Western Women's Junior at Cincinnati Country Club.

Claire Solovic, from Imperial, Missouri, leads the tournament with a 71, one over par. Close behind her with a 72, is Kristen Giles from Georgetown, Ontario, Canada. Elizabeth Coffren of Owings, Maryland carded a 73.

Claire Solovic attends Seckman High School and will graduate in 2020. Kristen Giles will attend Drake University in the fall 2018 and Elizabeth Coffren attends Northern H.S. and is a member of the class of 2020.

Six players are tied at 74.

Birdies were flying. Claire Solovic birdied holes #12, #13 and #17. Kristen Giles birdied #3, #11, #12 and #13. The field of players covered the course with birdies, with one exception, hole #9.

The consensus from the field was that the greens rolled well and the course was challenging. Caroline Crumrine, Wilmington, North Carolina, liked the greens commenting that they were "rolling fast".
